Foreword

The National Infrastructure Atlas is developed by the Namibia Statistics Agency (NSA) to provide critical information at regional level on major infrastructure development in the country. This is the first Atlas of this kind to be produced as part of the National Spatial data Infrastructure (NSDI) which is coordinated by the NSA. The Atlas can be used by decision makers as a guide for infrastructure improvement and planning at both regional and national level. The Agency used various sources of spatial data which can be delivered into maps. It must be noted that due to the observed poor maintenance of some of the datasets, some features or infrastructures do not have coordinates of their locations e.g. some schools in the northern part of the country. It must therefore be noted that the information presented reflects the current state of our national data hosted at the NSA as provided by the various custodians of these datasets.

This publication consists of eleven chapters with each chapter containing 15 maps, one national and the other for the 14 regions. The opening chapter emphasises on providing the reader with maps of the administrative organisation of Namibia and an introduction to its physical characteristics. The chapter contains the physical map of Namibia, land cover and the geophysical regions map, administrative map of Namibia, communal land and national parks map and the national borders, ports, harbours and airports. Chapters showing socio-economic infrastructure by constituency has population figures for all constituencies in a given region.

The chapters that follow contain the following:

Chapter 2: The chapter contains educational institutions in Namibia. Each region is mapped separately resulting in 14 maps for the chapter. Each map presents the location of educational institutions as per their educational classification; Combined Schools, Junior Primary, Junior Secondary, Special and Tertiary. This is in accordance with the classification as provided by the Ministry of Education, Arts and Culture.

Chapter 3: This chapter displays all health facilities. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for this chapter, each map presents the location of health facilities in the region, showing the following health facility classes; Clinics, Health Centres, Hospitals, and Voluntary Counselling Centres (VCT).

Chapter 4: This chapter contains water facilities in the country. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for the chapter. Each map displays the location of water features in a given region and the map is further categorised by the different water features as follows; Dams, Canals, Water Supply Points, Boreholes, Pipelines, Water bodies and Rivers.

Chapter 5:

This chapter contains agricultural extension offices which are government offices that provide some kind of agricultural services to the community. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for the chapter.

Chapter 6:

This chapter displays the transportation network of Namibia. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for the chapter. Each map presents the location of railways, district roads, main roads and trunk roads in a given region.

Chapter 7:

This chapter contains proclaimed urban areas in the country. This refers to urban areas that are declared as such and published in the government gazette in terms of the Local Authorities Act or Regional Councils Act. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for the chapter. The classification of proclaimed urban areas is as follows: municipality, town, village and settlement area.

Chapter 8:

This chapter shows the location of police stations in the country. Each region is mapped separately resulting in 14 maps for the chapter.

Chapter 9:

This chapter displays the location of post offices in the country. Each region is mapped separately resulting in 14 maps for the chapter.

Chapter 10:

This last chapter contains local government offices in the country. Each region is mapped separately making 14 maps for the chapter. Each map shows the location of local government offices in a given region based on the following office classification; constituency office, municipality office, regional council office, settlement office, town council office, and village council office.

The NSA is hopeful that this Atlas will be useful in providing needed information for evidence-based planning as well as for the layman to use for navigation. Local, regional and national governments can use this information to further improve the infrastructure for the betterment of the citizenry.




Map 1.1. Physical Map of Namibia



Map 1.2. Land Cover and Geophysical Features of Namibia




Map 1.3. Administrative Map of Namibia



Map 1.4. Administrative Map of Namibia - North Central




Map 1.5. Communal Land and National Parks Boundaries





Map 1.6. National border posts, harbours and airports









Map 2.3. Erongo - Educational Institutions






Map 2.6. Kavango West - Educational Institutions









Map 2.8. Khomas - Educational Institutions - Continued




Map 2.9. Kunene - Educational Institutions



Map 2.12. Omusati - Educational Institutions









Map 2.13. Oshana - Educational Institutions





Map 2.14. Oshikoto - Educational Institutions





Map 2.15. Otjozondjupa - Educational Institutions

Map 3.1. National - Health Facilities










Map 3.4. Hardap - Health Facilities







Map 3.5. Kavango East - Health Facilities






Map 3.10. Ohangwena - Health Facilities

Map 3.14. Oshikoto - Health Facilities








Map 3.16. Zambezi - Health Facilities





Map 4.5. Kavango East - Water Infrastructure






Map 4.6. Kavango West - Water Infrastructure





Map 4.13. Oshana - Water Infrastructure








Map 4.15. Otjozondjupa - Water Infrastructure






Map 5.6. Kavango West - Agricultural Extension Offices






Map 5.7. Khomas - Agricultural Extension Offices










Map 5.10. Ohangwena - Agricultural Extension Offices






Map 5.13. Oshana - Agricultural Extension Offices



Map 6.3. Erongo - Transportation Network




Map 6.4. Hardap - Transportation Network






Map 6.7. Khomas - Transportation Network








Map 6.8. Kunene - Transportation Network






Map 6.11. Omusati - Transportation Network





Map 6.12. Oshana - Transportation Network




Map 6.13. Oshikoto - Transportation Network








Map 6.15. Zambezi - Transportation Network









Map 7.4. Hardap - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.5. Kavango East - Proclaimed Urban Areas




Map 7.6. Kavango West - Proclaimed Urban Areas






Map 7.8. Kunene - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.9. Ohangwena - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.12. Oshana - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.13. Oshikoto - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.14. Otjozondjupa - Proclaimed Urban Areas





Map 7.15. Zambezi- Proclaimed Urban Areas



Map 8.5. Kavango East - Police Stations





Map 8.11. Omaheke - Police Stations



Map 8.12. Omusati - Police Stations





Map 8.13. Oshana - Police Stations




Map 8.14. Oshikoto - Police Stations




Map 8.16. Zambezi - Police Stations

Map 9.5. Kavango East - Post Offices




Map 9.6. Kavango West - Post Offices


Map 9.7. Khomas - Post Offices








Map 9.12. Omusati - Post Offices






Map 9.14. Oshikoto - Post Offices






Map 9.16. Zambezi - Post Offices






Map 10.6. Kavango West - Regional and Local Government Offices









Map 10.8. Khomas - Regional and Local Government Offices - Continued

Map 10.10. Ongwena - Regional and Local Government Offices





Map 10.11. Omahake - Regional and Local Government Offices





Map 10.12. Omusati - Regional and Local Government Offices





Map 10.14. Oshikoto - Regional and Local Government Offices






Map 10.15. Otjozondjupa - Regional and Local Government Offices


